Position	Year Four Classroom Teacher in a 1:1 iPad Classrooms – Fulltime Ongoing to begin 1 January 2018

We are seeking a dynamic and enthusiastic teacher to join our innovative teaching staff in Term 1 2018. This is an opportunity to join a school where the focus is on working with every student to reach their very finest potential in all aspects of their development. St Joseph's School runs a parent funded 1:1 iPad program in Year Four to Year Six. Our new Year Three to Year Six contemporary classrooms are designed to complement the integration of iPads as a creative learning tool.

This is a full time ongoing positions commencing 1 January 2018.

St Joseph's is a single stream co-educational school with 200 students from Pre-Kindergarten – Year 6. The school is located in modern premises, just a five minute drive from Kalgoorlie, the city centre, and is adjacent to the Parish Church. The school enjoys a close relationship with the Parish and strong support from the parent community.

Kalgoorlie-Boulder, with a population of about 35,000, offers an attractive lifestyle providing restaurants, take-aways, cafes, a cinema complex and shopping comparable with other major centres. It is just a one hour flight from Perth. In addition, a large indoor recreation facility, located within walking distance of St Joseph's, offers large heated swimming pools, indoor courts, a gym and café.

Assistance with re-location and accommodation, as well as an air-conditioning subsidy is included.

Selection Criteria:

Applications are invited from enthusiastic and innovative educators with the following attributes:

- Possess demonstrated excellence in teaching and classroom management as a dynamic, innovative and reflective practitioner who strives for excellence and exhibits a desire to assist each student to achieve their potential;
- An understanding of and the ability to differentiate the teaching and learning program to cater for a variety of student needs;
- Ability to analyse and use data to inform teaching and learning practises in order to raise student levels of achievement;
- Demonstrate a high level of interpersonal and organisational skills and the ability to work collaboratively with staff, students and parents;
- Be a positive, reflective and enthusiastic teacher who demonstrates initiative;
- Demonstrate a sound understanding of the Western Australian Curriculum;
- Be highly proficient in the use of ICT skills and successfully integrate ICT, especially iPads and Mac Books, into the curriculum in order to engage, motivate and improve teaching and learning;

- Experience with Apple iPad devices in a school setting;
- Knowledge and application of 21st Century Learning Pedagogy;
- Demonstrate a high degree of professionalism and a desire to continue to improve;

Qualification/s Required:

- exhibit an active personal witness to the Catholic Faith;
- relevant four year tertiary qualification and
- Accreditation to Teach Religious Education Learning Area, or the ability to achieve Accreditation to Teach Religious Education
