We are seeking a visionary, dynamic and enthusiastic leader to join the Leadership Team in 2018. This is an opportunity to join a single stream co-educational school with just over 200 students from Pre-Kindergarten – Year Six, where the focus is on working with every student to reach their very finest potential in all aspects of their development.

This is a full time ongoing position commencing 1 January 2018. A two year secondment would also be considered with approval from the applicant's principal.

St Joseph's School is a warm, intimate and friendly environment where all children are challenged to reach their potential in a Catholic context. School priorities are to provide a safe, positive and encouraging atmosphere for all students to grow, along with a proactive approach to teaching and learning based on the effective use of data. There is an emphasis on students being engaged at all times; being accountable for their own learning; and being confident and self-assured lifelong learners. The school enjoys a close relationship with the Parish and strong support from the parent community.

In catering for the needs and interests of each individual student there is a wide range of quality experiences for students to develop physically, emotionally, socially, spiritually and academically. A rigorous and varied curriculum is provided across all learning areas, including the specialist areas of Health, Visual Arts, Science and Physical Education. A Gifted and Talented Program, Reading Recovery, MiniLit, You Can Do It!, Chess Club and Coding Club are also offered to students. St Joseph's School is well resourced with iPads in all year levels, as well as interactive whiteboards and touch LCD screens with Apple TVs in all classrooms. From Year Four, the school runs a parent funded 1:1 iPad program. The modern and contemporary classrooms complement the integration of technology and provide students with the opportunity to collaborate within an engaging learning environment.

Kalgoorlie-Boulder, with a population of about 35,000, offers an attractive lifestyle providing restaurants, take-aways, cafes, a cinema complex and shopping comparable with other major centres. It is just a one hour flight from Perth. In addition, a large indoor recreation facility, located within walking distance of St Joseph's, offers large heated swimming pools, indoor courts, a gym and café.

Assistance with re-location and accommodation, as well as an air-conditioning subsidy is included.

Selection Criteria:

Applications are invited from enthusiastic and innovative educators with the following attributes:

- Demonstrate a high level of competency and capability to support the principal in the Learning, Engagement, Accountability and Discipleship aspects of school leadership;

- A high level of initiative, innovation and the ability to work as part of a collaborative and dynamic leadership team;
- Demonstrate a high level of interpersonal and organisational skills and the ability to work collaboratively with staff, students, parents and the parish in developing a harmonious community atmosphere;
- Highly organised, with an understanding of school administrative work, accountability and deadlines;
- Comprehensive knowledge of current educational theories and practices and a proven ability to lead staff in educational change, curriculum development and professional learning;
- A sound understanding of the Australian Professional Standards for Teachers and the Australian Teacher Performance and Development Framework;
- Lead curriculum enhancement and change in the school through the implementation of contemporary learning programs;
- Possess demonstrated excellence in teaching as a dynamic, innovative and reflective practitioner who strives for excellence;
- Possess expertise and capacity to lead staff in ICT integration into the curriculum;
- Ability to analyse and use data to lead staff in raising student levels of achievement and school improvement processes;
- Experience in leading the school community in liturgical celebrations and guiding teachers in the implementation of the Religious Education units of work;
- Active membership of the Catholic Church, as evidenced by a Parish Priest reference;
- Demonstrated involvement in school and parish life, including participation in out-of-school activities.

Desirable expertise and experience:

- Coordinator of Professional Learning would be an advantage;
- Experience with Apple iPad devices in a school setting;
- Early childhood experience and knowledge of NQS/EYLF.
