Student numbers have been steadily improving in the second half of 2017, which will in turn increase the schools 2018 income.

Thank you to the P&F for the significant contribution to the school's classrooms in 2017, continuing a great tradition of purchasing furniture, TV's and Touchscreens.

I must also congratulate all involved with the financial improvement of the school's canteen, there has been a significant reduction in the cost of providing this service to the school community and an improvement in the product, well done.

The 2018 budget has been prepared for CEOWA approval. It is expected that the 2018 budget will return a positive result of \$22,518.00.
