SCHOOL UNIFORMS

School Uniforms

We have noticed a number of students wearing their uniforms incorrectly. As a reminder, here are the things that seem to be causing the most issues:

- No other shirt should be worn under the sports, or winter uniform. There have been a number of students wearing long sleeve tops under short-sleeved uniform tops for warmth. This is not permitted. If extra warmth is needed, the appropriate school jumper, or jacket, should be worn. Alternatively students may wear a singlet under their shirts, provided it is not visible.
- The zip up sports jacket can only be worn with the sports uniform. On other days, the woollen jumper should be worn.
- On sports days, children should be wearing black tracksuit pants. Leggings are not permitted.
- Appropriate lace up, or mary-jane style school shoes need to be worn with the winter uniform. Joggers are not permitted, except with the sports uniform.

Please remember to label all items of clothing.
