Ten years ago, on 13 February 2008, then
Prime Minister Kevin Rudd delivered a
poignant apology to the Stolen Generations,
which became known as 'Sorry Day'.

For many indigenous and non-indigenous
Australians, Sorry Day is an important day
to recognise the wrongdoing, acknowledged
by the government, about earlier
assimilation policies.

After recently re reading the transcript
of Mr Rudd's apology to the indigenous
people of Australia I took notice of a
particular part, early in Mr Rudd's speech.
He states that "We the Parliament of
Australia respectfully request that this
apology be received in the spirit in which it is
offered as part of the healing of the
nation" and "We today take this first step by
acknowledging the past and laying claim to a
future that embraces all Australians".

I am of the firm belief, that for us to move
forward as one people, we need to truly hear
the words of Mr Rudd, accept each other as
individuals and embrace a future that involves
all Australians.

This day gives all Australians the opportunity
to come together and share steps towards
healing for families and communities affected
by the assimilation programs.
