## School Uniform

(For students in Pre-Primary – Year Six)

Updated: September 2018

### Grooming for both girls and boys

Hair should be neat and tidy, and should not reflect the extremes of any current fashions. Hair must be trimmed above the eyebrows and be kept free of the face. If below the collar, or long enough to be tied up, it must be tied back with an elastic band, ribbon or scrunchie in the school colours - yellow and green – or in a colour to match their hair (eg. dark hair should use black, or dark brown elastics and blonde hair should use white, or light brown).

It would be impossible to list all the hair styles and colours that would be inappropriate. Here we ask parents to support the school. While some tips and colour may be added, it must enhance the natural colours of the hair. Colours like pink etc, would see the child sent to the office where they will await their parents to collect them and rectify the problem before their return to school. Acceptable hairstyles will be at the discretion of the principal.

### Jewellery for both girls and boys

No jewellery may be worn other than a functional watch, a cross and chain. A maximum of one piercing per ear is acceptable with plain gold, or silver, sleepers or studs. Facial piercing is unacceptable and would see the child sent to the office where they will await their parents to collect them and rectify the problem before their return to school.

<p><b>BOYS</b> <b>(Year 1-6)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Grey shorts (grey trousers also allowable)</li> <li>• Grey shirt (crest on pocket)</li> <li>• Green knitted v-neck school jumper</li> <li>• Black flat school sandals or black school shoes (runners not acceptable and sandals only when shorts are worn)</li> <li>• Grey socks (when not wearing sandals) – not footlet style</li> <li>• <b>Until the end of 2020, boys may wear brown flat school sandals, as per previous policy</b></li> </ul>
<p><b>SPORTS</b> <b>(PP- Yr 6)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Plain black unisex shorts, as sold by the uniform shop</li> <li>• Green school polo shirt (worn one day per week in Yr 1-6)</li> <li>• House coloured polo shirt (worn one day per week in Yr 1-6)</li> <li>• White socks</li> <li>• Predominantly black, or white, low-cut joggers with matching black, or white laces. PP may also wear black sandals.</li> <li>• Plain black tracksuit pants (not leggings)</li> <li>• Zip-up sports jacket (only to be worn with sports uniform)</li> </ul>

**PARENTS MUST ENSURE ALL JEWELLERY IS REMOVED WHEN PARTICIPATING IN TEAM SPORTS.**

**NAIL POLISH**

Only clear nail polish can be worn by students from Pre-Primary to Year 6.

**SCHOOL HAT**

It is mandatory for all children in Pre-Primary to Year 6 to wear the school hat. The school has a 'no school hat, no play' policy.

**GLOVES & SCARF**

On cold days children may wear a scarf and/or gloves but the colour must be only black.

**WINDBREAKERS**

The school has available for order fleece lined windbreaker jackets that may be worn with, but not instead of, the school jumper on cold days. The windbreaker may be worn with the sports uniform.

**UNIFORM CARD**

Should a child be in incorrect uniform, a Uniform Card will be sent home (see below) as a reminder of the uniform expectations. If your child is unable to adhere to the Uniform Policy for a short period (eg. injury meaning they cannot put on the school jumper, shoes damaged and waiting to purchase new ones), a note of explanation should be provided to the class teacher.
